On Memorial Day 2015, the Deadwood Pioneer Cemetery hosted a very successful **Pioneer Heritage Day**, featuring food, Civil War artifacts, uniforms and a reenactment of the first burial in 1883. It was such a hit that we want to do it again! We will once again provide drinks, hot dogs and chili, and welcome potluck sides and/or desserts. This year we hope to feature pioneer and local Indian heritage, and will also honor the first Civil War veteran buried in DPC.
