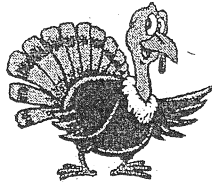

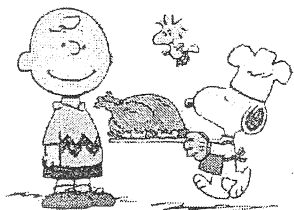

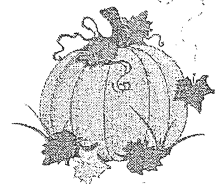

You probably know that 4 out of 5 of our county commissioners are still considering enacting a law that would give them the power to decide which initiatives the People can vote on. Due to public outrage at their attempt to meddle with the People's initiative system (not the commissioner's business) AND to try to move the goals posts in the middle of the game, they have backed off for the moment, but plan to revisit their over-reaching law in February. This means we need to really step it up, to get our two initiatives qualified, before they pull their end-run. Please contact us if you can help us gather signatures to get the Lane County Aerial Spray ban and the Right to Local Community Self-Government charter amendments on the November 2017 ballot.
