I recently learned that the phone and internet lines will no longer be buried but strung on electric poles in some areas in Deadwood. Our phone service has been super reliable for the 27 years we have lived here. The electric service goes out very frequently due to trees falling on the power lines, sometimes taking out poles. In addition to the week long outage in January, we have had at least 3 other outages at our house so far this year. There is no cell phone service here so Pioneer is the only way to have contact with the outside world. This is particularly important when the power is out. Please keep the lines buried. 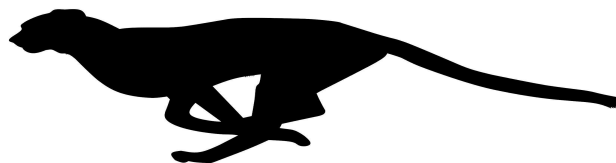
Mayday Fun Run

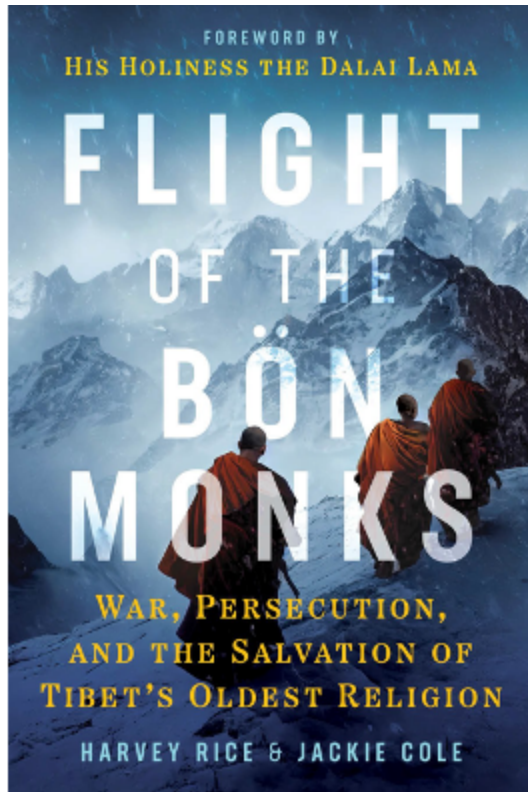
